#### 3. Ruby Bluff Repeater

**a.** Unfortunately, there is nothing new to report. We need to keep an eye on this issue so that we do not get a big surprise in the future.

## 4. Radio Frequency Licensing renewal

a. Need to be on the lookout for invoice from FCC

#### 5. Pre-Positioning

- a. First reimbursement received for \$46.432.32, The following data was not updated with this check
- **b.** As of 10-16-24 the department has be assigned to around 37 days of Pre-Positioning. (Difference being the time spent on the Bear Fire)
  - i. Truck Rental is approximately \$151,000
  - ii. May be different when Ca-OES finalizes starts and stops times for engine in service,
    - 1. (16 Hours per day)
  - iii. It is asked that this revenue be placed in the Apparatus Fund
- c. There will be an Administrative Fee of 10% paid
  - i. To date approx..\$29,000

# 6. Equipment update. (if not mentioned in service with no changes in status)

- a. 7342, Being repaired for a suspension problem
- **b. 7343.** Staff discussing disposition
- c. 7344. In the process of being repurposed to service as a backcountry Med/utility/rescue unit
- d. 7346, Department decals ready for installation,
- **e. 7360,** Department decals ready for installation. Operational, but still needs some tweaking. Working towards getting it registered with the state so we can receive rental in the future.
- f. 7362, Needs some minor changes to be better equipped for Pre-Po duties
- g. 7381, still no movement. May need to make a call to "Baja Liz"

#### 7. Major Purchases for updated equipment

- a. 2000 feet of new 21/2 supply line 7380,7360, and 7362. Included in this order will be 11/2 forestry hose, wyes, and fittings. Approximate cost \$15,000. The cost will be funded by the Association, so there will be no impact to the District budget
- b. Pump Trailer. In the planning process. Still considering size shape weights. No purchases at this time.

- 8. Grants Update, Quarterly updates completed.
  - a. California Fire Fighters Foundation, Supporting the pump trailer that is in progress
    - i. 2023 grant compliance requirements completed
  - b. Office of Traffic Safety. Completing annual compliance requirements
